

# Important Safety Notice

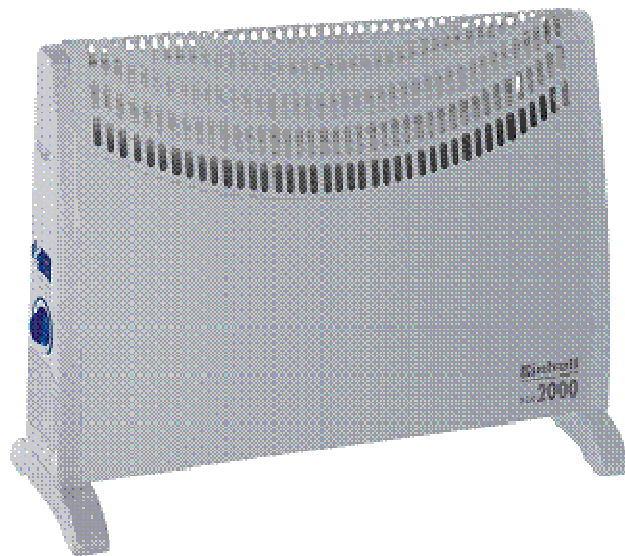
Einhell has discovered that on KON 2000 and KON 2000 TT with the numbers

Art. No. 23.386.00 (KON 2000) or  
23.386.50 (KON 2000 TT)

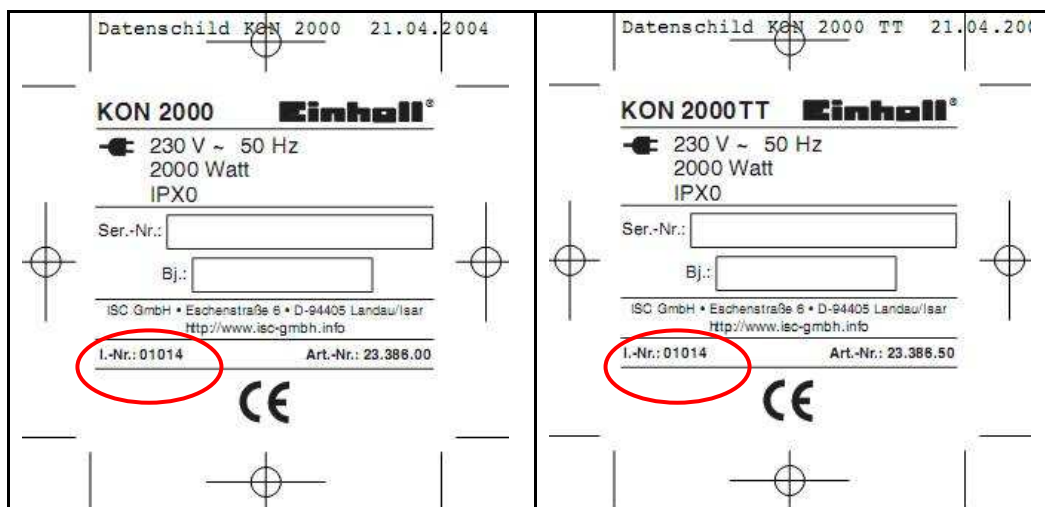
and

ID No. 01014,

which were supplied to the trade between 2004 and 2007 there is a risk that the device will catch fire as a result of the ignition of the plastic components of the device. This means that there is also a risk of considerable personal injury and property damage.

Label on the affected model KON 2000 and KON 2000 TT bearing ID No. 01014

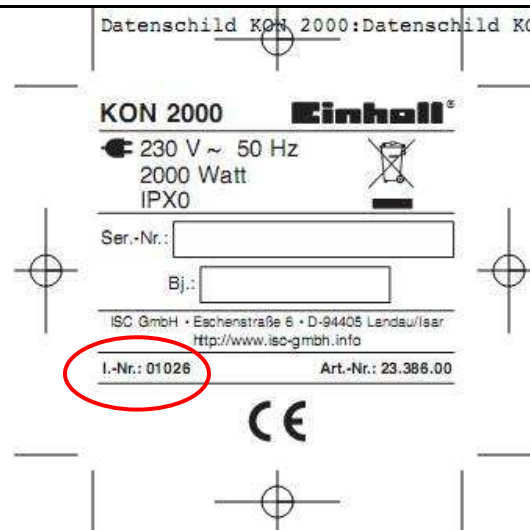
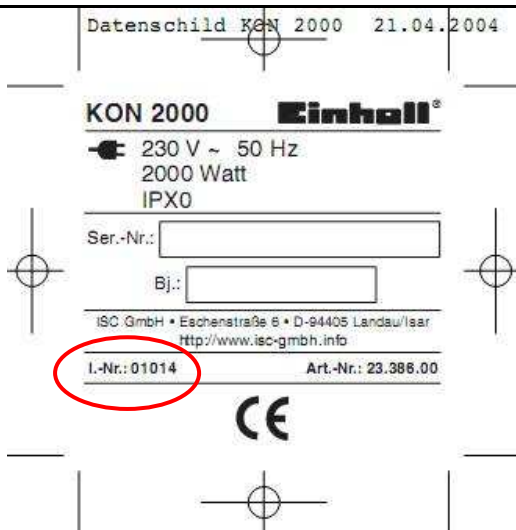
**IMPORTANT!**

The KON 2000 and KON 2000 TT products with the same Art. No. 23.386.00 and 23.386.50 but with **ID No. 01026** which were supplied to the trade as from spring 2007 are **NOT** affected by this warning notice. In addition to the ID numbers, these devices also differ from the affected ones by the fact that the model with ID No. 01014 has blue switches whilst the model with ID No. 01026 has gray switches.

### What should you do?

- Please **check** whether your product bears one of the two **Art. No. 23.386.00** and **23.386.50** **and ID No. 01014** on its model plate. The model plate (label) is at the rear right-hand side at the bottom. If the model plate is no longer fitted, please check whether your device has blue switches.
- **Because of the risk of fire the affected devices are to be disconnected from the mains immediately (pull the plug) and not used again.**
- Customers who have installed the device using a hard-wired electrical cable contrary to our safety information in the operating instructions are requested to uninstall the device immediately and not use it again. This poses a particular fire risk because the devices are not designed for this type of use.
